ANTI-CORRUPTION TRAINING

PROCUREMENT ANTI-CORRUPTION TRAINING

Procurement Anti-Corruption Training is a five-week programme that aims to reduce corruption in public procurement by training professionals in sound anti-corruption strategies. Taught by leading experts (and frequent IACA lecturers) Christopher Yukins and Max Kaiser Aranda, and enriched by distinguished guest lecturers, it combines one week of on-site training at IACA with four weeks of distance learning in participants' home countries.

During the training, each participant writes a course paper that recommends how an important anti-corruption strategy could be implemented in his or her home country.

PROGRAMME BENEFITS

Combining theory with real-world insights, Procurement Anti-Corruption Training brings measurable benefits for:

- **Procurement officials** looking for a deeper understanding of red flags and likely areas of corruption.

Participants benefit from high-level peer discussion and subsequently join the Academy's alumni network, comprising over 1,100 anti-corruption and compliance professionals from about 150 countries.


