

Master's Thesis Defence Rules for External Attendees

(latest update 13032023)

The master's thesis defence is open to the public. Anybody who wishes to attend one or several sessions may join via the Microsoft Teams link published on IACA's website. However, all external attendees [other than student defending and the DC members] are required to follow the rules below:

1. All external attendees are requested to join the session before the official start of the defence. Latecomers will not be admitted to the session.
2. The external attendees will be admitted to the session only after the student defending the thesis. This may cause a slight delay in admitting.
3. Everybody apart from the defence committee members and the student defending the thesis shall always keep the microphone and camera off and shall not interfere in the defence process in any way.
4. Once external attendees are requested to leave the session, they are expected to do so immediately.
5. The external attendees are not allowed to record or take pictures.
