### **Dean Emeritus, INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION ACADEMY (IACA) & Executive Secretary Emeritus of IACA's Assembly of Parties**

Mr. Martin Kreutner is Dean Emeritus of the International Anti-Corruption Academy (IACA) and its former Executive Secretary of the Assembly of Parties.

Born in Innsbruck/Austria in 1964, he holds a Master's degree in law from the University of Innsbruck (AUT), and a Master's degree in Policing and Public Order Studies from the University of Leicester (UK). He was a commissioned officer in the armed forces including a total of five years with different international (UN and PFP) field missions. After his transfer to the Federal Ministry of the Interior (AUT) in 2001, he was commissioned to build up the Austrian federal anti-corruption authority, which he headed from 2001 to 2010.

Prior to his appointment as Dean of IACA, Mr. Kreutner was Executive Secretary of IACA's Provisional Assembly and its multilateral Provisional Commission, elected Chairman of its International Steering Committee, and Chairman of IACA's International Transition Team.

From 2004 to 2012, he was (founder and) President of the network *European Partners Against Corruption* and the EU's European Anti-Corruption Contact Point Network (EPAC/EACN), an association of the European Anti-Corruption Authorities.

He is/was member of, *inter alia*, the Legal Symposium Advisory Committee of the *European Forum Alpbach*, the Executive Committee of the International Association of Anti-Corruption Authorities (IAACA), INTERPOL's International Expert Group on Corruption (IGEC), the Advisory Council of Transparency International - Chapter Austria, the OMV Resourcefulness Advisory Board, and the International Advisory Board of the Malaysia Anti-Corruption Academy (MACA). Among his other functions, Mr. Kreutner is/was a senior anti-corruption evaluator/peer reviewer/advisor for, *inter alia*, the United Nations, the Council of Europe, the European Union, the Organisation for Security and Co-operation in Europe (OSCE), Transparency International, and the World Bank; he also is co-editor of the *Compliance Praxis* magazine.

Mr. Kreutner frequently lectures on (anti-)corruption, compliance, the Rule of Law, and international (humanitarian) law at numerous universities, academies, and institutions, and is author of many articles, papers, and publications on (anti-)corruption, compliance, the international system, and security issues. For eight years each, he was Chairman of the Austrian Supreme Disciplinary Tribunal and Member of the Austrian Federal Appeals Tribunal.

Both in 2014 and 2015, Mr. Kreutner was recognized by *Ethisphere* (USA) as one of *100 Most Influential People in Business Ethics* for his efforts to combat corruption with IACA, as well as his efforts to improve human welfare worldwide through his work with the United Nations, Transparency International, and other global organizations.
