**RESOLUTION  
ON FINANCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY AND STABILITY  
OF THE INTERNATIONAL ANTI-CORRUPTION ACADEMY**

The Assembly of Parties,

*Recalling* Articles II and XI of the *Agreement for the Establishment of the International Anti-Corruption Academy as an International Organization* (hereinafter referred to as “the Agreement”),

*Recalling also* its unanimously adopted Resolution AOP5-Res-2 of its fifth session entitled “*Resolution on Financial Stability and Sustainability of the General Budget Allocation for the International Anti-Corruption Academy*”,

*Encouraging* Parties and other donors of the International Anti-Corruption Academy (hereinafter referred to as “IACA” or “the Academy”) to make voluntary contributions to the organization, in accordance with Article XI of the Agreement,

*Welcoming* the strategic objective of the IACA Work Programme 2017-2020 on ensuring financial ownership, participation, stability, and sustainability,

1. **Invites** IACA to continue its efforts to refine its financial accountability and reporting to the Parties of the Agreement and other donors on the use of their voluntary contributions to the organization;
2. **Stresses** the importance of establishing an open-ended intergovernmental working group on financial matters in line with the strategic objective of the IACA Work Programme 2017-2020 on ensuring financial ownership, participation, stability, and sustainability;
3. **Decides** to convene at least one open-ended expert meeting to elaborate on the modalities of the working group, including its terms of reference;
4. **Decides also** that the working group will be of a transparent and advisory nature and will be aimed at formulating recommendations to refine the Academy’s financial accountability and stability in line with Article XI of the Agreement;
5. **Requests** the Secretariat to provide logistical support for the open-ended expert meeting;
6. **Decides** that the open-ended expert meeting will report on practical results of deliberations to the Assembly of Parties.
