

## *Curriculum Vita*



***Professor Fayyad Alqudah*** was born in Amman, Jordan in May 1<sup>st</sup>, 1960. He obtained his *LL.B* in private Law from University of Jordan in 1986, an *LL.M* (with Distinction) from University of Edinburgh in 1989 and *PhD* in Law from University of Edinburgh in 1992. He joined the teaching Staff in School of Law at the University of Jordan in 1992 and became full professor of law in 2010. He was admitted to Jordan Bar Association in 1995 and since then he was in practicing law.

Professor Alqudah became Dean of the School of Law at the University of Jordan in 2016. He is a board member of Jordan Judicial Institute and member of trustees of the University of Applied Sciences in Jordan, Member of the Board of Trustees of the Hashemite Fund for Badia Development and ex-Board member of King Abdullah II Design and Development Bureau-*KADDB*.

Professor Alqudah was a member of Jordan Anti-Corruption Committee (2010-2012). He chaired Investigation Committees in many anti-corruption cases in Jordan. Prof. Alqudah was a member in the Committee that represented Jordan in submitting a self-evaluation report on the compatibility of Jordan legislation with United Nations Convention on Anti Corruption, member of Evaluation Committee of Compatibility of Iraqi legislation with United Nations Convention on Anti Corruption, represented Jordan in UNCAC parties' annual conference meetings in Vienna in 2011 and in 2012.

Prof. Alqudah has been hosted many times by local and international media stations relating to Jordan Measures to compact corruption delivering many lectures and attending local and international conferences relating to anti- corruption measures in addition to attending Parliament discussions relating to enacting or amending legislation relating to anti corruption.

Prof. Alqudah in his capacity as a licensed attorney represented high ranking institutions and companies including Government of Jordan, US Embassy in Jordan, University of Jordan, University of Jordan Science and Technology, King Abdullah I Hospital, National Petroleum Company Central Bank of Jordan, and Social Security Investment Fund.

Professor Alqudah taught law for more than 25 years in graduate and postgraduate levels. He supervised many master and *PhD* theses and published many articles in legal matters. He is an author of a book on Jordan Commercial Law.
