RESOLUTION

The Assembly of Parties,

Encouraging strongly all Signatories which have not yet concluded the ratification process of the *Agreement for the Establishment of the International Anti-Corruption Academy as an International Organization* (hereinafter referred to as "the Agreement"), and *calling upon* UN Member States and International Organizations which have not yet acceded to the Agreement, to do so at their earliest convenience so that they can enjoy the benefits of full membership, and so that stable geographical diversity, including participation from the African Group, can be ensured with all organs of the Academy;

1. Elects, pursuant to Article V paragraph 3(d) of the Agreement, the following persons as members of the Board of Governors (in alphabetical order):

- Mr. Sergey N. Dubik, Adviser to the President of the Russian Federation [six-year term]
- Mr. Hermann Feiner, Director-General in the Austrian Federal Ministry of the Interior [six-year term]
- Dr. Jorge Juan de Dios Fernández Tapia, General Director of Investigation of Corruption Acts, Ministry of Transparency and the Fight Against Corruption of the Plurinational State of Bolivia [three-year term]
- Dr. Young Ran Kim, Chairperson at the Anti-Corruption & Civil Rights Commission of the Republic of Korea [three-year term]
- Professor Mordechai Kremnitzer, Professor (Emeritus) at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem, and Vice President of Research at the Israel Democracy Institute [three-year term]
- Dato' Sri Abu Kassim bin Mohamed, Chief Commissioner of the Malaysian Anti-Corruption Commission (MACC) [six-year term]
- Mr. Daniel Marius Morar, First Deputy of the General Prosecutor of Romania [three-year term]
- H.E. Ms. Margarita Popova, Vice-President of the Republic of Bulgaria [six-year term]

- Prof. Dr. Pakdee Pothisiri, Commissioner of the National Anti-Corruption Commission (NACC) of Thailand [three-year term]
- Mr. Eduardo Vetere, former Director of the Division for Treaty Affairs of UNODC [six-year term]
- Ms. Cecilia Villanueva Bracho, Deputy Head of Mission and Alternate Permanent Representative of Mexico [six-year term]

2. Takes note with appreciation of their commitment to take on the important duties entrusted to them, and **recommends** that they meet at the earliest convenience but not later than within the next three months, and take all necessary decisions to provide for continuity and the further successful development of the Academy.
