**RESOLUTION ON THE NEXT
WORK PROGRAMME AND BUDGET**

The Assembly of Parties,

1. **Notes** with appreciation the achievements made by IACA under the Work Programme 2014–2016, as adopted by the Assembly of Parties with its Resolution AOP2-Res-1.
2. **Decides** that IACA’s work shall continue on the basis of the Work Programme 2014–2016, which is herewith prolonged, until a new Work Programme and the related Budget(s) are to be adopted by the Assembly of Parties.
3. **Encourages** all Parties to contribute to the new Work Programme by sending to the Secretariat their replies to the Survey distributed by the Secretariat and included in the annex of this Resolution.
4. **Requests** the Secretariat and all relevant organs of the organization to coordinate this process, and to present a draft Work Programme to the sixth session of the Assembly of Parties.

Survey on the upcoming Work Programme 2017–2019 (draft)¹

Since its inception IACA has been recognized by numerous international bodies and other fora for its work in the area of anti-corruption and compliance education, technical assistance, and capacity-building. In 2015, the Academy received explicit tribute in two United Nations resolutions thereon. Even with very limited resources, in little more than five years IACA's programmes and activities have *empowered professionals* from more than 145 jurisdictions around the world. Likewise, its culturally and geographically diverse in-house and visiting faculty includes some of the world's most renowned and esteemed academics, scholars, practitioners, and professionals.

In order to shape the organization's next Work Programme 2017–2019 even better around the requirements and needs of its constituency, Member States – at their convenience – are kindly invited to share with the Secretariat their thoughts and perspectives on the following questions.

1. In which areas of anti-corruption/compliance education, technical assistance, and capacity-building would you like to see IACA play a stronger/additional role?
2. Which additional services *vis-à-vis* Member States would you envisage IACA developing and delivering?
3. Which areas and subjects of research would you regard as particularly important for IACA to get engaged in?
4. In which areas of international cooperation would you like to see IACA play a stronger/additional role?
5. More and more stakeholders argue that existing anti-corruption indices do not sufficiently reflect efforts, developments, and achievements by states in preventing and fighting corruption. Would you like to see IACA taking a (leading) role in developing a new, comprehensive, scientifically based measurement that also takes on board the aforementioned parameters?
6. In which of the above-mentioned areas would you be prepared and willing to pledge financial resources in order to allow for the realization and implementation of these targets?
7. Any additional proposals/comments.
