

English Language Proficiency

Applicants who are not native English speakers must provide evidence of English language proficiency through one of the following ways:

1) Minimum scores on English proficiency tests as outlined below:

- Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) – overall score paper-based 574, computer-based 210, Internet-based 89
- Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE) – corresponding level B2 of CEFR, Common European Framework of Reference for Languages
- Academic IELTS Test – overall score 6.0

English language test scores cannot be older than two years.

2) Completion of at least one year of full time university studies and/or professional experience in an English speaking country or in a tertiary institution where the language of instruction was English.

3) An academic degree where the language of instruction was English.

* Evidence of proficiency, including required documentary evidence set out above, must be provided together with the application form.
