ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of five years of relevant work experience, or alternatively, a level of junior engagement demonstrating the applicant's potential
- Proficiency in written and spoken English.

Participants will be selected based on their education and professional experience. IACA is committed to promoting diversity and strives to attract participants from various regional backgrounds.

TUITION FEE OPTIONS

2,340 EUR - also includes daily on-site catering with lunch, dinner, and coffee breaks as well as welcome and farewell dinners and social activities.

2,930 EUR - in addition to the above, IACA will book a room in a three-star hotel in Vienna for eight nights (including breakfast) and will provide a daily shuttle service between IACA and the hotel. The tuition fee is included in this price.
