

Barry O'Keefe



The Hon Barry O'Keefe AM QC was the Commissioner of the Independent Commission Against Corruption in New South Wales from 1994–1999, when he returned to judicial duties. Previously he was Chief Judge of the Commercial Division of the Supreme Court, Additional Judge of Appeal, Member of the Commonwealth's Group of Experts of Good Governance and Corruption, Chairman of Interpol International Experts on Corruption (2000–2012) and has undertaken anti-corruption assignments in Armenia, The People's Republic of China, Hong Kong, Italy, Malaysia, Pakistan and Thailand.

He was a Barrister for 36 years and Queen's Counsel for 19 years, President of the Bar Council from 1990–1991, member of a Metropolitan Council for 23 years and Mayor for 10 years. He was President of the National Trust for 15 years and was appointed Adjunct Professor in 2005 at the University of Notre Dame (Australia).
