

Friedrich Schneider



Friedrich Schneider is a full Professor of Economics. He was Vice-President of Foreign Affairs at Johannes Kepler University, Linz, Austria, from 1996-2007.

Professor Schneider obtained his PhD in Economics in 1976 from the University of Konstanz, Germany, and has since held visiting and honorary positions at several universities. From 1991 to 1996, he was Dean of Social Sciences and Economics at Johannes Kepler University, President of the Austrian Economic Association from 1997-1999 and President of the German Economic Association from 2005 to 2008. In addition, he was a consultant to several Austrian and German governmental institutions, including the Federal Austrian Ministry of Economics, the Austrian and the German Central Banks

and international organizations including the European Union Commission, the International Monetary Fund and the World Bank.

Having published extensively in leading economics journals including *The American Economic Review*, *The Quarterly Journal of Economics*, *The Economic Journal* and the *Journal of Economic Literature*, he has also written many books such as *Readings in Public Choice and Constitutional Political Economy* (with Charles K. Rowley) and *The International Library of Critical Writings in Economics, 2008* as well as editing two volumes of *The Economics of the Hidden Economy*.

Professor Schneider was the editor of the *Journal of Public Choice* from 1991 to 2004 and of the *Perspektiven der Wirtschaftspolitik* from 2000 to 2004.
