

Dr. Yong GUO

Dr. GUO Yong was born in Hanshan, Anhui Province in China. He holds Ph.D. in Management of Tsinghua University. He joined the faculty of Tsinghua University in April 2006 after graduation. He is currently the director of the Research Center for Anti-corruption and Governance, and also a professor in Public Policy and Management, vice chairman of the Tsinghua University Council.

Dr. Guo's professional fields include corruption measurement, anti-corruption policy, reform of anti-corruption agencies and administrative organs. He has published four books on corruption measurement, relations between the spread of corruption and economic transition, and the reform of anti-corruption agencies in China. His research papers were published in leading journals such as Communist and Post-Communist Studies, The China Quarterly, China Review, Crime, Law and Social Change, and certain Chinese journals.

Dr. Guo is also an active anti-corruption policy advisor to government authorities at various levels. He is a Specially-invited Ombudsman of the State Supervision Commission (China). His policy reports have attracted attentions of many top leaders in charge of anti-corruption issues, and have been cited by international journals such as the Financial Times, and the Wall Street Journal.

Dr. Guo has been the Sectary General of the Transparency International China for nearly ten years. He is one of the 14 scholars in the CPI methodology reform (2009). He is head of several research projects including the China National Integrity System Evaluation, and the Forestry Integrity and Governance. He has contributed a lot for the development of TI activities in China.

Dr. Guo currently lives with his family in Beijing.
